Previously, this organization has submitted information to you regarding the improper marketplace conduct of Construct Data Verlag, a company operating under Austrian law that has recently signed a broad settlement agreement with the Schutzverband gegen unlauteren Wettbewerb (an association in Austria that guards against unfair competition).

The Settlement agreement dated 13 February 2007 binds Construct Data to cease its egregious activities in the European Union, Switzerland and several other nations not including the United States.

Enclosed with this letter is IAEE's file on Construct Data containing various notices, correspondence and other items related to this matter including a letter dated 16 March 2007 from Frederik Hulden to Alumne Mfg. Incorporated in Wildwood, Florida.

As evidenced by the Hulden letter of 16 March 2007, and in light of the settlement agreement dated 13 February 2007 between Construct Data and the Schutzverband gegen unlauteren Wettbewerb, we have reason to believe that Construct Data is now refocusing its improper, deceptive and unfair trade practices primarily on businesses and individuals located in the United States.

Previous requests on our part for the intervention of the United States Federal Trade Commission in this matter have been largely unsuccessful. Given that there is now reason to believe that United States citizens and businesses are at even greater risk as the result of the settlement agreement of 13 February 2007 we are once again requesting the active intervention of the Federal Trade Commission to prevent Construct Data from continuing to conduct its improper activities in this nation.
